Grad-to-Grad Capacity Building Group (G2G)



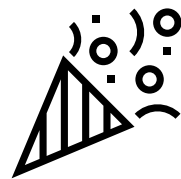
G2G empowers and provides grad-to-grad support to AEG students. The group helps create authentic and engaging opportunities for grad-to-grad conversations with more experienced students.
